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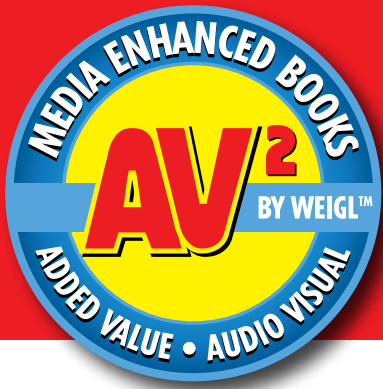

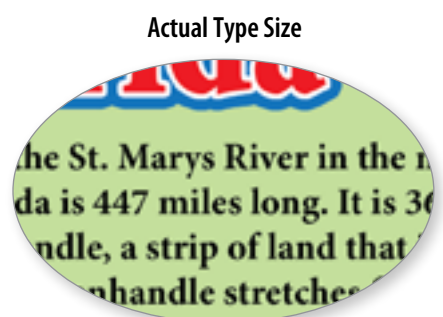

It is 361 miles wide across the northern panhandle, a strip of land that juts out from the larger area of Florida. The panhandle stretches from the Atlantic Ocean on the east to the Perdido River on the west. The greatest width of the Florida peninsula is 150 miles.

State Capital
Tallahassee is well known for being the only Confederate capital east of the Mississippi River that was not captured during the Civil War. Because of this, many of its older buildings were preserved, including beautiful plantation houses and the Old Capitol building. In fact, Tallahassee has two capitol buildings, the old one built in 1822 and the New Capitol building, completed in 1977. The Old Capitol building then became the Museum of Florida History.

Mountain Goat Life Cycle

Nannies and billies mate in the fall. Nannies give birth to one kid every spring. On rare occasions, a nanny will give birth to two kids.

Almost half of all mountain goats die in their first year of life. This is most often because of avalanches, rock slides, and severe weather. Those that survive their first year usually live for about 12 years.

Birth	One Day to One Month	One Month to One Year	Adult
At birth, mountain goats normally weigh about 7 pounds (3 kg). Kids are able to stand and eat a few minutes after birth. Within a couple of hours, kids start to run and climb.	After three days, a kid's horns start to show on its head. By three weeks, kids weigh about 40 pounds (18 kg). Kids drink their mother's milk for the first six weeks.	Kids stay close to their mother for the first year of life. The nannies and kids stay together in groups of up to 20.	Mountain goats are considered adults at about three years of age. As adults, nannies and billies live apart from one another. Males and females gather every fall for mating season.

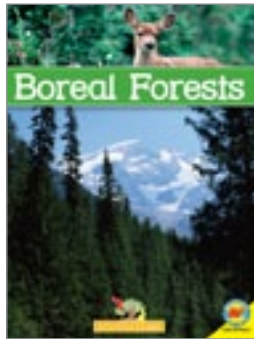

Glacier Movement

Glaciers move in two different ways. The way is to slide. The other way is to creep. Sometimes, ice flows like your feet. When it rains, a frozen lake melts. A thin layer of water flows under the ice. This allows the glacier to slide more easily. This is called sliding.

The other form of movement is called creep. The glacier is so heavy that ice layers flow on top of other ice layers. The weight of the top layers changes the glacier's shape slowly. The weight allows the glacier to creep.

Glaciers move faster in places depending on the terrain. Some areas are flat, and the glacier flows. In a glacier's main flow, it can move only a few centimeters every day. Other glaciers only move about a meter (3.3 feet) every day. In 2007, a fresh water glacier in Alaska moved 100 meters (328 feet) in one month.

As a glacier moves, it can take a long time to reach the ocean. It can take a glacier 100 years to reach the ocean.

Cape Canaveral, where space vehicles are tested and launched, is also the site of several science research companies.

The first railroad in Florida ran 22 miles from Tallahassee to Port Leon on 19 March 1831. It was completed in 1836.

The first astronauts to land on the moon lifted off from the Kennedy Space Center on July 16, 1968.

Marion County is famous for its hundreds of Thoroughbred horse farms and has been called the "Horse Capital of the World."



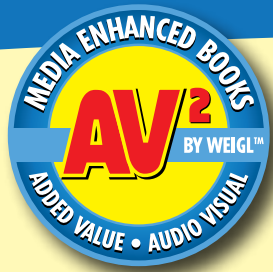
